

Contractual provisions relating to Russia

- (1) Any resale, onward supply, provision or re-export of the goods and technologies covered by this contract into the territory of the Russian Federation, in respect of which export bans or restrictions apply, as well as any provision or supply for use within the territory of the Russian Federation, is expressly prohibited and constitutes a breach of applicable Swiss and EU law.
- (2) The buyer is furthermore obliged to ensure that the purpose of paragraph 1 is not thwarted by third parties further down the supply chain, including any resellers, and must establish and maintain an appropriate monitoring mechanism for this purpose.
- (3) In the event of a breach by the buyer, MULTIVAC is legally obliged to report this to the competent authority in Switzerland / the EU and points out that the customer's name may consequently be placed on a Swiss / EU blacklist. Furthermore, MULTIVAC must review the business relationship with the buyer and is entitled to take appropriate legal action.
- (4) The buyer expressly undertakes, in the event of a breach of this prohibition – whether intentional or negligent – to cooperate fully with MULTIVAC and all competent authorities immediately upon discovery or suspicion of any breach, including all relevant activities of third parties, to assist in clarifying all circumstances and, as far as possible, to help prevent the delivery or provision of the goods.
